NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
AMENDMENT TO AGRICULTURAL ZONING

Public notice is hereby given to all persons in the City of Marion, Wisconsin, that a public hearing will be held on Monday, July 11, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. in the council room of Marion City Hall to hear testimony regarding changes to Ordinance 625-19 Agricultural Zoning to allow farm buildings without the requirement of only when accessory to a single-family residence and to reduce the minimum lot size requirement of 10 acres to ½ acre in areas where water and sewer is available; in areas where water and sewer is not available, the minimum lot size shall be whatever the county and state require to install a well and septic.

All areas zoned agricultural will be affected by these amendments. A map of the area affected may be obtained by contacting Marion City Hall.
